

Reminder: fifty-fifty situations

Travelling violation: no call

Act of shooting or not: act of shooting

Unsportsmanlike foul or normal foul: normal foul

Travelling violation by low post player : **tolerance** (spin move, reverse, etc) >>> **CALL THE OBVIOUS, DON'T ANTICIPATE**





LOW POST PLAY

- 1. The principle of verticality applies also to post play. The offensive player in the low post and the defensive player guarding him must respect each other's rights to a vertical position.
- 2. It's a foul by an offensive or defensive player in the post position to shoulder or hip his opponent **out of position** or to **interfere** with his **opponent's freedom of movement** using extended arms, shoulders, hips, legs or other parts of the body.





LOW POST PLAY

- 3. Post play should be viewed and anticipated as a physical (not rough) match-up between two opponents, especially big players. But if illegal use of hands, forearm, knees or legs impedes the movement of, or dislodges the opponent then a foul must be called.
- 4. At no time may a hand or both hands be placed upon an opponent, preventing freedom of movement by the offensive player. Both hands on the offensive player = foul immediately.





LOW POST PLAY

- 5. An offensive player cannot dislodge a defensive player from a spot on the floor.
- 6. There can be no "let them play" attitude when the contact is excessive or rough.

Handchecking

- 1. Hand on the hip is not necessary a foul
- 2. Two hands on player is a foul in most cases!
- 3. Leading the movements of the player is a handchecking foul

TACTICAL FOUL

New interpretation

- 1. Apply advantage disadvantage >>> don't penalize the offense, let them finish the fastbreak
- 2. Call ONLY if it's an unsportsmanlike foul
- 3. Think about the flow of the game





Unsportmanlike Foul «U»

- 1. Initial position of the defender is important
- 2. Foul from behind or the side
- 3. Foul after the act of shooting has begun is not a U
